This summer, Adela will be sailing up to Canada. She then plans to return to the Caribbean in winter.

Adela is just one more reason to come visit North Cove and Battery Park City in Lower Manhattan. It's not often you get an opportunity to look over the railing at a yacht of such magnificence. Adela is a vision of beauty, varnished wood, sparkling metal and grace.
